When:

Games will be played at 6 pm, 7 pm or 8 pm and held on a Mondays, Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday beginning May 29 for a 5-week season. Teams will play 1-2 games per week with a guarantee of at least 8 games total.

Format:

7v7 (6 field players + a goalkeeper)
Roster minimum of 10 players/maximum of 18 players
Two 25-minute halves
Games will be self-coached by a team volunteer, such as a school coach or parent. The coach must register as a volunteer and complete a background check in order to be approved to coach.

Fees:

\$70 per player that covers registration fees
